Please order your child’s lunch on the MYCAS app. This is a great opportunity for you to discuss the lunch options with your child and encourages them to try new foods.

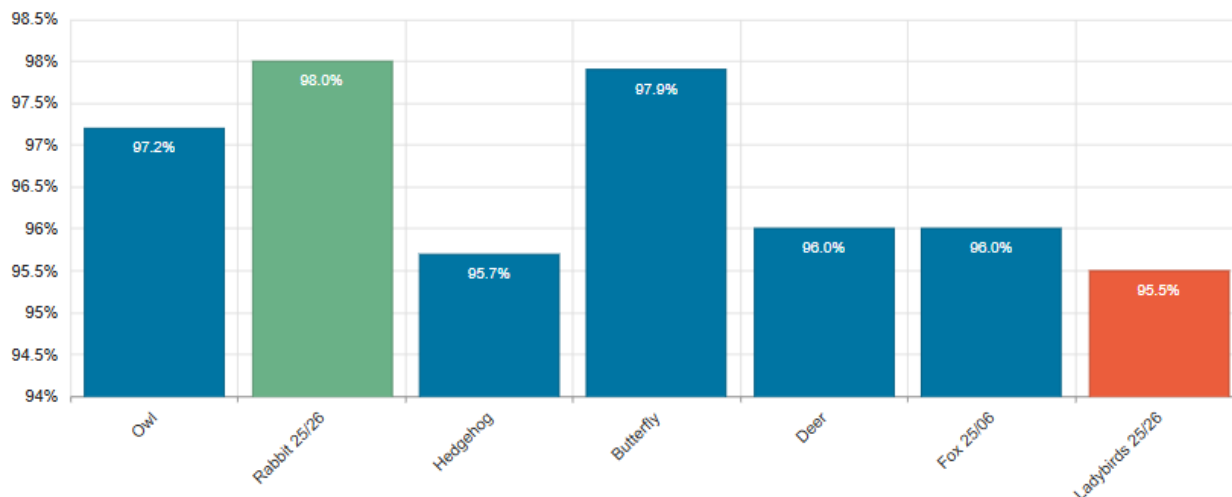

Is my child too ill for school?

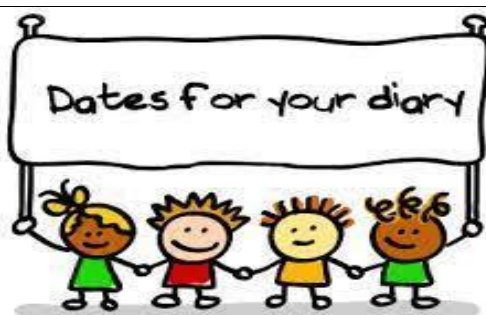
It can be tricky deciding whether or not to keep your child off school, nursery or playgroup when they're unwell.
